**I have met and reviewed the public testimony with sub-committee chairs Ken Sobel and Bill Garrett. We also took the opportunity to review the Prop “R” Bond text and related Education Codes governing /associated with the Grossmont/Cuyamaca Bond.**

**We do not believe that our overview responsibilities include specific direction to the publicly elected Governing Board as you infer. However, our *oversight* does require that we evaluate the plan(s) for Repair & Construction as it pertains to the entire District as Prop R specifies. We are not charged with a parochial perspective as to individual components or site. That remains a duty of the College Board.**
